MEDICAL SUPPLIES FOR AL-AHLI ARAB HOSPITAL



Project cost: \$600,000 Start date: October 2023 Close date: May 2024

- Provided salaries for **90** staff
- Provided salaries for **30** temporary staff
- Provided food for 9,000 people
- Provided 28,100 liters of fuel
- Provided medicine and medical supplies for 31,500 people
- Provided essential items including an X-ray machine, sterilizing machine, and more
- Provided specialized surgeries for 3,000 people
- Provided burn treatment for 4,000 people
- Provided outpatient services for **3,500** people
- Provided psychosocial support for 700 children and adults

SUPPORTING THE LOCAL HEALTH SYSTEM IN GAZA

IRUSA worked to increase the capacity of local health facilities in Gaza through providing emergency medical supplies including medicine to treat severe and moderate injuries; disposables such as catheters, syringes, gloves, masks, and more; and laboratory reagents.

ACCESS TO BASIC NEEDS FOR VULNERABLE PEOPLE

- Provided medical care to 47,903 people
- Provided more than 100 medical items to three hospitals including Al-Ahli Arab Hospital, Al-Awda Hospital, and Hayfa
- Provided access to medicine for
 62,475 internally displaced people through three mobile medical clinics
- Provided gender-sensitive hygiene kits to 2,451 families in 10 Gaza City shelters and 450 families in one shelter in Jabalia
- Provided food parcels to **42,340** people during Ramadan
- Distributed 1,262,000 liters of clean water
- Provided adequate clothing for 11,400 people
- Provided 62,600 individual meals and 39,066 family meals during Ramadan
