PROJECT IMPACT FOOD AID

OVERVIEW

The Integrated Food Security Phase Classification has found **nearly all households** in Gaza have been skipping meals or going entire days and nights without any sustenance as United Nations officials have been warning of an impending famine. Thanks to donors like you, IRUSA is working to provide vital food aid to families in need.

CURRENT PROJECTS

RAMADAN 2025

Project cost: \$1,000,000
Timeline: Feb. 2025 to July 2025
Proposed people served: 103,450

Planned Activities:

- Provide food vouchers to **10,000** people in the West Bank
- Provide produce baskets to **93,450** people in Gaza

PROJECT IMPACT HEALTHCARE

OVERVIEW

The attack on the health system has been particularly devastating – less than half of Gaza’s hospitals are partially functional, facing challenges with the shortage of medical staff and lack of essential medical supplies. The World Health Organization says more people will die of disease if we’re not able to put the health system back together. Thanks to your support, IRUSA is working to provide proper healthcare to people in need.

CURRENT PROJECTS

EMERGENCY SUPPORT FOR AL-AHLI ARAB HOSPITAL

Project cost: \$1,601,538

Timeline: Dec. 2024 to Feb. 2026

Proposed people served: 7,275

Planned Activities:

- Provide essential healthcare services to **7,200** people
- Provide **12,200** treatments to patients
- Hire **75** staff

AGENTS OF HOPE: GAZA YOUTH RESILIENCE PROJECT

Project cost: \$999,974

Timeline: Nov. 2024 to Jan. 2027

Proposed people served: 75,000

Planned Activities:

- Train **150** youth in physiotherapy and enroll **90** graduates in a two month internship to apply their skills in humanitarian efforts
- Train **120** midwives
- Train **60** youth to provide CPR, bandaging, and other emergency skills
- Train **120** youth to provide emergency psychological support
- Provide **100** youth with help to rebuild their business, psychosocial training, and recovery toolkits and enroll **60** youth entrepreneurs in a 36 hour training to develop their business plans



FORTIFYING THE PALESTINIAN MEDICAL SECTOR PHASE III

Project cost: \$5,675,000

Timeline: Oct. 2024 to Dec. 2026

Proposed people served: 420,204

Planned Activities:

- Enhance NGO hospital and primary health services via facility repairs/improvements and equipment procurements
- Provide limb prosthetics and assistive devices to amputees and severely injured people
- Provide primary healthcare services across **13** Bedouin communities through mobile medical teams (MMTs)
- Enhance disaster preparedness in **12** West Bank communities by providing community members with first aid training, emergency first aid kits, and medical supplies
- Increase the capacity of health facilities through pharmaceuticals, medical supplies, and lab reagents



HYGIENE KITS AND HOSPITAL BEDS FOR GAZA

Project cost: \$500,000

Timeline: Oct. 2024 to May 2025

Proposed people served: 40,000

Planned Activities:

- Provide **6,000** hygiene kits
- Provide **140** hospital beds to local healthcare facilities

ENHANCING HEALTHCARE SERVICES IN GAZA THROUGH MEDICAL MISSIONS

Project cost: \$596,253

Timeline: July 2024 to May 2025

Proposed people served: 3,000

Milestones:

- Provided medical services to **3,831** patients
- Trained **50** healthcare workers
- Provided **56,555** medical supplies including medicine to Al-Shifa Hospital
- Provided nutrition training for **25** dialysis patients

EMERGENCY MEDICAL AID

Project cost: \$596,253

Timeline: Jan. 2024 to Nov. 2026

Proposed people served: 280

Progress:

- Provided emergency first aid training to **128** people
- Provided psychosocial support training to **121** people
- Provided midwifery training to **48** people with a medical/nursery background



MEDICAL SUPPLIES FOR HEALTH FACILITIES IN GAZA AND THE WEST BANK

Project cost: \$1,000,000

Timeline: Sept. 2023 to March 2025

Proposed people served: 718,328

Progress:

- Provided medicine and medical supplies to **29** healthcare facilities including **16** in Gaza and **13** in the West Bank
- Provided **479,531** treatments to **70,000** patients in the West Bank and **4,858,688** treatments to **606,000** patients in Gaza
- Provided medical aid including non-communicable disease (NCD)/wound management to **19,500** IDPs

PROJECT IMPACT EMERGENCY RESPONSE

OVERVIEW

According to experts, about 55% of all infrastructure in Gaza has been destroyed while more than 90% of the population has been displaced multiple times. Thanks to your generosity, we're working to provide access to basic needs to our brothers and sisters in need.

CURRENT PROJECTS

GAZA INTEGRATED COMMUNITY SHELTER PROGRAM

Project cost: \$6,352,503

Timeline: Jan. 2025 to Dec. 2025

Proposed people served: 9,900

Planned Activities:

- Provide shelter assistance
- Provide access to food aid through Tekia community kitchens and fresh produce baskets
- Provide access to education for **1,200** students
- Provide access to proper healthcare
- Provide access to WASH services including drinking water, the installation of **300** WASH facilities, and **168** hygiene promotion sessions
- Access to essential NFIs to help families meet

their basic needs

- Access to sustainable livelihood opportunities for **60** women



ACCESS TO PROPER WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE (WASH) SERVICES

Project cost: \$1,000,000

Timeline: Oct. 2024 to Jan. 2026

Proposed people served: 40,000

Planned Activities:

- Provide access to clean drinking water through water trucking
- Provide access to latrines with a community-based waste management system
- Distribute essential non-food items (NFIs) including soap



PALESTINE WINTER 2024

Project cost: \$1,500,000

Timeline: Oct. 2024 to June 2025

Proposed people served: 49,665

Planned Activities:

- Provide shelter kits to **1,800** internally displaced families in Gaza
- Provide winter clothing kits to **6,000** internally displaced families in Gaza
- Provide cash assistance to **1,230** vulnerable families in the West Bank

WOMEN CAN 4.0

Project cost: \$2,400,000

Timeline: Sept. 2024 to Nov. 2028

Proposed people served: 440

Planned Activities:

- Provide small business support to **360** women
- Help **40** women improve their income
- Provide psychosocial support to **360** women

ACCESS TO HOUSEHOLD NEEDS FOR VULNERABLE FAMILIES

Project cost: \$6,271,252

Timeline: Nov. 2023 to Jan. 2026

Proposed people served: 78,670

Progress:

- Provided bedding kits to **10,134+** people
- Provided gender-sensitive hygiene kits to **2,144+** women
- Provided dignity and bedding kits to **1,728** people
- Procured **2,095** tents to be distributed to **1,865** people



ACCESS TO BASIC NEEDS FOR VULNERABLE PEOPLE

Project cost: \$8,100,000

Timeline: Oct. 2023 to June 2025

Proposed people served: 1,278,932

Progress:

- Provided access to medical care including psychosocial support for **385,655** internally displaced people through three mobile medical clinics
- Provided medical items to **eight** hospitals
- Psychosocial support including recreational activities and theater training for **13,374** adults and children
- Provided gender-sensitive hygiene kits to **2,451** families in **10** Gaza City shelters and **450** families in **one** shelter in Jabalia
- Provided food parcels to **184,133** people during Ramadan
- Distributed **30,453,000** liters of clean water
- Provided adequate clothing for **11,400** people
- Provided **62,600** individual meals and **39,066** family meals during Ramadan
