With your support, we distributed **176,544 food packages** in impoverished communities to provide relief during the blessed month of Ramadan. Through this effort we also distributed your **Zakat al-Fitr**, **Fidya**, and **Kaffara** payments in the form of food supplies to those most in need.

What's Inside a Food Package?

Depending on the region, our Ramadan food distributions are designed to provide essentials for a family for one month.

Food items vary according to regional cuisines and are purchased through local markets to support local livelihoods and the local economy and ensure high quality of products. In some countries there will be a mixture of food box distributions and cash and/or voucher assistance so that families can select their own food items.

Scaling Resilience and Poverty Solutions in Asia

This is being done by graduating families out of poverty, strengthening communities to climate and disaster shocks, and influencing national and provincial policy change.



PALESTINE

The latest wave of violence comes after over two weeks of no humanitarian aid – hundreds of people have been killed, including children, and thousands more injured. In response, IRUSA is supporting emergency efforts at Al-Ahli Hospital, where many of the injured were taken. We're also distributing pharmaceuticals and medical supplies to hospitals in the area treating the critically injured.

SUDAN

Two years of crisis in Sudan has created the world's worst hunger crisis, with famine spreading quickly across the country. Nearly 25 million people - more than half the population - are facing acute food shortages. Extreme violence against civilians and humanitarian aid workers, with hundreds of people killed in the last few weeks alone, has resulted in the suspension of vital humanitarian work and humanitarian catastrophe.

SYRIA

Nearly 14 years after peaceful protests quickly spiraled into civil war, opposition forces have taken back the Syrian city of Damascus. Where does this leave the people of Syria?

The standard of living has been set back by decades. More than 70% of Syrians are living in poverty, having lost their livelihoods and unable to meet their basic needs including access to food, clean water, or proper healthcare. The children of Syria are of the most affected as many don't know life outside of the war and will be forced to face the long-term effects of physical and mental trauma.
