## IMPACT REPORT SUDAN



### OVERVIEW

- **33.7M** people urgently require humanitarian assistance – half of them children
- **13.6M** people are displaced
- Nearly **29M** people – more than half the population – are acutely food insecure
- **10.2M** people are enduring severe [level 4] and extreme [level 5] food insecurity
- **4.2M** children under five and their mothers are expected to need treatment for acute malnutrition in 2026

### IRUSA COMMITMENTS IN SUDAN

**Rapid Emergency Response for Displaced Populations in Sudan:** *With generous support from the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB), IRUSA will be providing \$7M worth of humanitarian aid including access to proper healthcare, clean water, and shelter to conflict-affected communities in Khartoum, White Nile, and the Northern States.*

**Since April 23, IRUSA has committed \$21,350,170 towards Sudan.**

### IRUSA WORK

#### EMERGENCY HEALTH RESPONSE IN AL-KUFRA

**Project cost:** \$149,000

**Proposed people served:** 2,161 [Direct], 60 [Indirect]

IRUSA is working to provide access to primary and specialized healthcare services for vulnerable families in Southern Libya, primarily Sudanese refugees and host communities.

#### HEALTH AND SAFE SHELTER SOLUTIONS FOR SUDANESE REFUGEES AND HOST COMMUNITIES

**Project cost:** \$3,000,000

**Timeline:** Jan. 2026 to March 2027

**Proposed people served:** 152,350

IRUSA is providing primary healthcare services and safe, affordable housing to Sudanese refugees and host communities in Ethiopia.

## PROTECTION FOR REFUGEES, MIGRANTS, INTERNALLY DISPLACED PEOPLE (IDPS), AND VULNERABLE LIBYAN COMMUNITIES

**Project cost:** \$1,000,000

**Timeline:** Nov. 2025 to Jan. 2027

**Proposed people served:** 40,000 [Direct], 120,000 [Indirect]

IRUSA is working to provide access to proper healthcare services including primary, mental, and psychosocial support as well as access to safe spaces for vulnerable communities, including Sudanese refugees, living in Libya.



## EMERGENCY RELIEF FOR FORCIBLY DISPLACED PEOPLE IN SUDAN

**Project cost:** \$2,000,000

**Timeline:** Sept. 2025 to Nov. 2026

**Proposed people served:** 76,340 [Direct], 750 [Indirect]

IRUSA is providing life-saving support to 15,268 newly displaced families across Sudan amid one of the world's most severe humanitarian crises. So far, we've distributed 1,948 relief kits to families in need.



## REHABILITATION OF BAHRI HOSPITAL IN NORTH KHARTOUM, SUDAN

**Project cost:** \$1,400,000

**Timeline:** Sept. 2025 to March 2026

**Proposed people served:** 100,000 [Direct], 1,500,000 [Indirect]

IRUSA is restoring critical health services to over 1.5 million vulnerable families and returnees in Sudan.



## SUPPORTING NEWLY DISPLACED FAMILIES IN TAWILA AMID ESCALATING EL FASHER CRISIS

**Project cost:** \$508,000

**Timeline:** Dec. 2025 to Feb. 2026

**Proposed people served:** 25,000 [Direct], 150,000 [Indirect]

IRUSA is implementing an integrated emergency response in Tawila, North Darfur, to address the urgent needs of families newly displaced from El Fasher. The project will deliver primary and maternal health care, nutrition services, safe water and sanitation, and emergency shelter support for people living in overcrowded settlements.



## PAST WORK

### RAMADAN RELIEF PROGRAM 2026

**Project cost:** \$105,000

**Timeline:** Feb. 2026 to Mar. 2026

**Proposed people served:** 9,850

IRUSA provided hot iftar meals and food baskets to highly vulnerable communities in Tripoli and Azzawiya, including Sudanese refugees.



### EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR SUDAN CRISIS

**Project cost:** \$2,000,000

**People served:** 145,889

IRUSA provided immediate emergency aid to vulnerable communities across the Gedaref, North Kordofan, and Red Sea states in Sudan.

### INTEGRATED LIFE-SAVING EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR CONFLICT-AFFECTED IDPS IN SUDAN

**Project cost:** \$3,200,000

**People served:** 54,406

IRUSA improved the wellbeing of displaced families in Sudan through food security, access to clean water, access to proper healthcare, and more.

### EMERGENCY RELIEF FOR SUDANESE REFUGEES IN CHAD

**Project cost:** \$2,000,000

**Timeline:** July 2024 to Feb. 2025

**People served:** 27,915

IRUSA provided access to safe, livable conditions for 27,915 new Sudanese refugees in Chad, including the Alacha site in the Ouaddai province and the Kerfi site in the Sila province.

### EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR MIGRANTS ARRIVING FROM SUDAN

**Project cost:** \$149,000

**Timeline:** Aug. 2023 to Dec. 2023

**People served:** 1,080

IRUSA helped meet the basic needs of displaced families in Egypt by providing cash assistance and community awareness sessions.

### RESPONDING TO THE SUDANESE REFUGEE INFUX IN EASTERN CHAD

**Project cost:** \$200,000

**Timeline:** Aug. 2023 to Nov. 2023

**People served:** 12,300

IRUSA helped meet the basic needs of newly arrived refugees, returnees, and their host communities by providing hot meals and other essential non-food items and supporting the integration of new arrivals with others in and around the camps.
